### Day 2 Rotterdam - Giethoorn – Amsterdam

#### 🍽 Breakfast

After breakfast, depart for a picturesque village, Giethoorn, a "Green Venice" in the northern part of Amsterdam. In this typical Dutch village, rejuvenate yourself with the fresh air, the relaxing calm, by enjoying the sound of the water and bird singing. Cars are prohibited in the village. The houses are located on a myriad of islands surrounded by an interweaving system of canals and interconnected by 176 small wooden bridges. Departure to Amsterdam, capital of the Netherlands, visit of the famous diamond factory and learn of the technology of diamond cutting and test the quality. Possibility for a cruise on the numerous canals of the city: discover by boat, on both side of the canals, the rich legacy of the city. Most buildings were built during the golden age of Amsterdam. See the main landmarks: Noorderkerk on the Noordermarkt square, the Westerkerk and the tallest belfry of Amsterdam, the house of Anne Frank and the Homomonument.
