The church's roof is supported by 100 radial beams and pillars, and at the same time inlaid with transparent glass, you can't feel underground. Feeling the quietness and deepness hidden in the city.

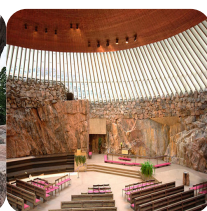

【Alexand Alexandr Nevsky Cathedral】

Tallinn's tallest and tallest domed Orthodox church. Located in the upper city of Tallinn, the cathedral is a Russian Orthodox church built in the 19th century, named after Alexander Nevsky, who resisted the invasion of Teutonic knights in the 13th century. From here you can admire the whole old town and the city of Tallinn.

【Tallinn Town Hall】

The Tallinn Town Hall is a building located in Tallinn, the capital of Estonia, located on the Town Hall Square in the Old Town of Tallinn. It is the only Gothic town hall in the Baltic States. The unique and historic architectural gem of Estonia.

Day 5 Riga - Rondelle Palace - Trakai Castle - Vilnius

 Overnight at 3-4 star hotel near Vilnius

 Breakfast

After breakfast, visit the old town of Riga.

【Old town of Riga】

It is located on the right bank of the Daugava river, with a small area surrounded by canals. The old town has the characteristics of a medieval city: the houses are low, the narrow streets and the roofs are mostly in red tiles.

【Blackhead Palace】

The Blackhead Palace was built in 1344. It is a building located in the old town of Riga, the capital of Latvia, next to the Old Town Square in Riga and belonging to the Brotherhood of Blackheads. The building was bombed by German planes in 1941 and was left in ruins. The current building was rebuilt in 1995. The Blackhead Palace is one of the most beautiful buildings in the old town. It attracts countless people every day to stop and take photos.

【National Opera of Latvia】

One of the greatest achievements in Latvian architectural and cultural history, completed in 1918, brought fresh blood to classical music and became the most famous cultural center.

【House of the Three Brothers】

The Maison des Trois Frères is located behind the church square. It is an example of different styles of buildings in the old town of Riga. These three buildings represent the architectural style of Riga in different periods of the Middle Ages. Complete stone building.

【Saint Peter's basilica】

The church contains 6,768 pipes, which is one of the largest pipes in the world.

After lunch, visit the Rondelle Palace, 70 kilometers from Riga.

【Palais du Rondaire】

The Rondelle Palace is the most remarkable Baroque building of the three Baltic countries, built in the first half of the 18th century under the direction of the Italian architect Rastrelli. Designate. The architectural style is magnificent and the room is decorated with 18th century furniture, paintings and porcelain.

Travel to Vilnius, the capital of Lithuania, and visit Trakai Castle on the outskirts of Vilnius.

【Trakai Castle】

The most famous site in Trakai, Lithuania. Built in 1409, it is the only water tower in the Baltic region. It is made of bricks and orange-red stones, surrounded by a conical spire with a medieval observation tower in the shape of a knight and a ditch in the city. The ancient castle in the setting sun stands on the water, bringing a fantastic beauty.

Day 6 Vilnius-Minsk

 Overnight at 3-4 star hotel near Minsk

After breakfast, drive to Minsk, Belarus, and visit after arrival.

【Tear Island】 The monument on the Island of Tears was built in memory of the Belarusian soldiers and soldiers who lost their lives during the Soviet invasion of Afghanistan. It is a monument to more than 800 soldiers and soldiers killed in Belarus.


【Victory Square】 Victory Square is located in the center of Minsk and was built to commemorate Soviet and Belarusian soldiers from the Second World War. The significance of the square for Belarus is equivalent to the significance of Moscow's Red Square for Russia. With 38 meters high.


【Cathedral of the Holy Spirit】 The Cathedral of the Bishop of the Holy Spirit is an emblematic building of the city of Minsk in Baroque style. After its completion, it experienced its ups and downs, witnessed the rise and fall of the city of Minsk and witnessed the heroic struggle of the city's inhabitants to defend their dignity.

After breakfast, visit the Mir Castle on the outskirts of Minsk.

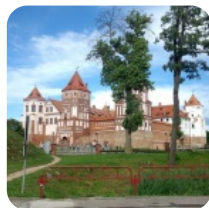
【Chateau du Moulin】 Chateau du Moulin, one of the cultural heritages of the world, was first built with the popularity of Gothic architecture. It was then rebuilt in the Baroque style during the Renaissance. After having been abandoned for almost a century and badly damaged during the period of Napoleon I, the castle was restored at the end of the 19th century. . After lunch, direction Vilnius and visit upon arrival.

【Vilnius Cathedral】 Vilnius Cathedral is located on the main church square at the foot of the Getiminas, it and the 57-meter-high bell tower occupy the main square. The church was built in 1387-1388 and was the first Gothic wooden church to be restored thereafter. The Saint Casimir chapel inside the church is Baroque, with murals depicting the life of the Lithuanian saint and his silver coffin.
